Dear Mr. Lewis:

In 1952 a number of letters I had written to the Escanaba Press regarding the old "White Pine Days" were published under the name of "Lumberjack."

The original issue of 100 copies was put out at the expense of Ernst & Ernst, nationally known Public Accountants. Harold Klagstad, a former Manistique boy, was Manager of their Chicago Branch. This was done on condition that I give them 25 copies for Christmas gifts to their friends. The other 75 copies were given away to personal friends.

Since then I have had many letters from and interviews with folks who wanted me to put out another edition. I have been working 2 years on this later edition and it will contain everything comprised in the 1st edition and about 50% more material, stories, maps, pictures, etc.

I have had quite a number of applications recently for copies of the new edition when published, -- one just received from a prominent Lawyer in Buffalo is for 10 copies as soon as published.

The MSS for the new edition will be completed and ready for publication in about 4 weeks, and I would like to get in touch with a reliable publisher who would be interested in publishing same.

Any information you can give me along this line will be appreciated.
